

WHAT MEDICATIONS SHOULD I TAKE FOR MY SURGERY?

<p>1. <u>ANTIBIOTICS</u> (START ONE DAY BEFORE SURGERY) – TAKE AS DIRECTED ON BOTTLE.</p>	
<p>2. <u>NSAIDS</u> (i.e., Ibuprofen) – EVERY 6-8 HOURS AS NEEDED.</p>	
<p>3. <u>HALCION (TRIAZOLAM)</u> – ORAL SEDATIVE. TAKE 1 PILL THE NIGHT BEFORE SURGERY, TO HELP YOU GET A GOOD NIGHT’S REST AND 1 PILL AN HOUR BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE. <u>AN ESCORT IS REQUIRED, DO NOT DRIVE!</u></p>	
<p>4. <u>PERIOGARD (CHLORHEXIDINE)</u> – ANTI-BACTERIAL RINSE, TO BE USED THE DAY AFTER PROCEDURE (AS DIRECTED ON THE BOTTLE).</p>	
<p>5. <u>ZYRTEC-D</u> (Over-the-Counter) – TAKE AS DIRECTED. START 3 DAYS PRIOR TO SURGERY.</p>	
<p>6. <u>CLARITIN-D</u> (Over-the-Counter) – TAKE AS DIRECTED. START 3 DAYS PRIOR TO SURGERY.</p>	
<p>7. <u>MEDEROL-DOSE PACK</u> - (SEE PICTURE FOR PREVIEW OF PACKAGE INSERT, WHICH PROVIDES DIRECTIONS FOR USE). START DAY OF SURGERY.</p>
