COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Implants are highly predictable and have become an integral part of oral rehabilitation. However, it is not immune to complications. In many instances, it requires elaborate treatment planning with potential post-restorative complications. This lecture will discuss important prosthodontic considerations that may help clinicians make the best decision on whether implant therapy is the best option for a compromised dentition. The aim of this lecture is to present an algorithm that will address clinical deductive reasoning, based on the scientific literature. Multiple clinical cases highlighting prosthodontic issues will be presented.

- Recognize the most significant prosthodontic factors that needs to be taken into consideration when considering implant placement.
- Identify appropriate interdisciplinary treatment modalities that can help improve prognosis of implants.
- Identify potential prosthodontic complications associated with implant therapy.
