Educational Objectives:

- Review current indications and timing considerations for third molar removal based on contemporary evidence.
- Identify patient-specific and anatomic risk factors associated with complications such as inferior alveolar nerve injury, sinus exposure, periodontal defects on second molars, infection, and alveolar osteitis.
- Discuss contemporary imaging strategies, including CBCT utilization, for surgical planning and risk mitigation.
- Explain the biologic mechanisms of platelet-rich fibrin (PRF) and its role in wound healing and bone regeneration.
- Analyze current clinical data supporting PRF use in third molar surgery (and use in other periodontal and oral surgery), including effects on pain, swelling, trismus, and osteitis rates.
- Formulate an evidence-based approach to incorporating PRF into third molar surgery within their own clinical setting.
